### Limited Eligibility

The following individuals are **NOT** eligible:

- Students with **F1 Visas** on their first year but can apply in subsequent years.
- Students with **J1 Visas**.
- Students enrolled in the professional programs of veterinary medicine and law.
- Students enrolled at Texas A&M University Galveston, Texas A&M University Qatar, and the Texas A&M Health Science Center (Medicine, Dentistry, Pharmacy, Public Health, Nursing)

The following individuals **ARE** eligible

- Mexican nationals that will be applying for the **Mexican Citizens with Financial Need Waiver** are eligible with an F1 or J1 visa in any year.
- Continuing International undergraduate and graduate students seeking degrees from the **College Station campus**.

Complete the entire application and submit it through the portal, fax, mail or drop it off in person to the Scholarships & Financial Aid Office. **Do not leave any blanks.** Enter "N/A" (for not applicable) if a question does not apply to you.

#### **Tax Information in English and in US Dollars:**

##### **DEPENDENT students submit the following:**

- Parent(s) 2022 signed tax return OR income statement from their country or employer.
- Student's 2022 signed tax return OR tax transcript from the Internal Revenue Service (IRS)
- 2022 W-2's for ALL wages
- 2022 1098/1098T (if applicable) for all other earnings (for example fellowships.)

\*If you and/or parent(s) did not work in the U.S. in 2022, but you or your spouse did work in another country, you must submit official documentation from your employer indicating the income earned and taxes paid.

##### **INDEPENDENT students submit the following:**

- Student/Spouse 2022 signed tax return OR tax transcript from Internal Revenue Service (IRS)
- 2022 W-2's for ALL wages
- 2022 1098/1098T (if applicable) for all other earnings (for example fellowships.)
- Submit an 8843 tax form if you did not work

\*If you and/or spouse did not work in the U.S. in 2022, however you or your spouse did work in another country, you must submit official documentation from your employer indicating the income earned and taxes paid.
